I. INTRODUCTION:

Sri Venkateswara Institute of Medical Sciences (SVIMS), Tirupati, established in the year 1993, under the aegis of Tirumala Tirupati Devasthanams, as a modern super speciality hospital, became a university in the year 1995 by an act of A.P. state legislature vide act no.12 of 1995. The objectives of the institute are:

- a) to create a centre of excellence for providing medical care, education and research facilities of a high order in the field of medical sciences in the existing superspecialities and such other super-specialities as may develop in future, including continuing medical education and hospital administration.
- b) To develop patterns of teaching in undergraduate &postgraduate level and in super specialities so as to set a high standard of medical education.
- c) To provide for training in paramedical and allied fields, particularly in relation to superspecialities.
- d) To function as a referral hospital.
- e) To provide for post graduate teaching and conduct of research in the relevant disciplines of modern medicine and other allied sciences, including inter-disciplinary fields of physical and biological sciences.

The institution, spread in a 107.04 acre campus, has 38 super/broad speciality medical departments, three constituent colleges and is a centre of excellence providing medical care, education and research activities of a high standard in the field of medical and other allied sciences. SVIMS also provides training in para-medical and allied fields.

The Institution is recognized by the University Grants Commission (UGC) under section 12 (B) of the UGC act, 1956, and Medical Council of India (MCI) has granted permission and later recognition to start DM/M.Ch. super-speciality courses in Cardiology, Neurology, Nephrology, Endocrinology, Medical Oncology, Cardiothoracic Surgery, Neurosurgery, Urology, Surgical Oncology, Surgical Gastroenterology and PG Medical (MD) courses in Anaesthesiology, Emergency Medicine, Microbiology, Nuclear Medicine, Biochemistry, Pathology, Medicine, Immuno Haematology & Blood Transfusion, Radio Diagnosis and Radiotherapy. The latest addition is MBBS course permitted from 2014-2015.

The constituent colleges are:

- 1) **SVIMS, Sri Padmavathi Medical College for Women (SPMC-W):** The college was permitted by Govt. of India for admitting MBBS students with 150 annual intake w.e.f. 2014-15 academic year. For the year 2018-19, Govt. of India permitted for admitting 5th batch of 150 students. This college is meant exclusively for women.
- 2) College of nursing: The college of nursing was established in the year 1996, with the objective of providing graduate, postgraduate teaching and for conduct of research in the relevant disciplines of modern nursing. Courses offered are B.Sc. (nursing), M.Sc. (nursing) and Ph.D. The college has excellent infrastructure with well equipped laboratories, advanced teaching and learning facilities.
- 3) **College of physiotherapy:** The College of physiotherapy was established in the year 1998. The college offers graduate and postgraduate courses in physiotherapy, in-patient and outpatient services and special services through obesity pain, paediatric clinics, advanced physiotherapy, ergonomics & life style modification.

The other interdisciplinary departments are;

- 1) **Biotechnology:** The department of Biotechnology established in 2003, is offering M.Sc. Biotechnology with intake of 15 students per annum and Ph.D. programmes. The successful students are absorbed in industrial organizations, who are leaders in production of drugs, vaccines, etc. They have also been in various national level examinations like CSIR, GATE, ICMR, BCIL (biotechnology consortium India Ltd., New Delhi).
- 2) Bioinformatics: The Department of Bioinformatics established in 2003, is offering M.Sc. Bioinformatics with intake of 15 students per annum and Ph.D. programmes. The students are selected in various National level examinations like GATE, ICMR, Bioinformatics Industrial Training Programme, New Delhi (BIITP). The successful students are absorbed in industrial organizations, and software companies. The DBT, ministry of science and technology, Govt. of India has sanctioned the Bioinformatics centre to support teaching and research work. The Bioinformatics infrastructure facility was housed in the Department of Bioinformatics. The Bioinformatics centre offers two studentships for final semester M.Sc Bioinformatics students and two traineeships for M.Sc Bioinformatics students every year. The students selected under this scheme are awarded a stipend of Rs 8,000/- per month for a period of six months.

II. ADMISSION CRITIRIA:

(1) Total seats permitted: 150

i. All India Quota: 15% i.e. 22 seatsii. NRI Category: 15% i.e. 23 seatsiii. Merit Category: 105 seats

- (2) The women candidates are only eligible.
- (3) Educational Qualifications: The candidates should have passed two years Intermediate (10+2 pattern) or equivalent examination with Physics, Chemistry, Biology (Botany, Zoology) / Bio-technology and English individually and must have obtained not less than 50% marks taken together in Physics, Chemistry, Biology (Botany and Zoology) / Bio-technology. In respect of the candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribes and the Backward Classes the marks obtained shall be a minimum of 40% taken together in Physics, Chemistry, Biology (Botany, Zoology) / Bio-technology. The OC-PH candidates shall have obtained not less than 45% marks taken together in Physics, Chemistry Biology (Botany, Zoology) / Bio-technology.
 - a. Candidates should have qualified in NEET (UG) 2018 conducted by CBSE Govt. of India
 - b. **Age:** should have completed the minimum age of 17 years by 31st December, 2018.
 - c. Candidates possessing qualification of the University / Board or an institution outside the State shall enclose the Migration Certificate and Eligibility /

Equivalence certificate from the Board of Intermediate Education of Andhra Pradesh / Competent authority from Govt. of India to the effect that the qualification possessed is equivalent to or higher than Intermediate examination conducted by the Board of Intermediate Education of Andhra Pradesh. It applies to NRI candidates also.

III. Admission Process:

- 1. **All India Quota :** 15% i.e. 22 seats are to be filled by the Medical Counseling committee (MCC), DGHS, Govt. of India. For details of counseling schedule, please refer to MCC web site : (www.mcc.nic.in)
- 2. **NRI Category**: 23 seats are to be filled by Dr NTRUHS, Vijayawada. For details of counseling schedule, please refer to DR NTRUHS web site: (www.drntruhs.ac.in)
- 3. **Merit Category:** The remaining seats (105) to be filled by Dr NTRUHS, Vijayawada. For details of counseling schedule, please refer to DR NTRUHS website: (www.drntruhs.ac.in)

<u>Note:</u> The admissions are not conducted directly by SVIMS university for any of the seats in the above categories.

1. VENUE FOR REPORTING: The Selected candidates after generating the allotment order from DGHS / DR NTRUHS shall report to the Principal of the Medical College within the date prescribed in the order. Those who do not report within the schedule as notified by the counseling authority, their seat gets cancelled automatically without further notice.

- 1. The Candidates selected under merit category shall bring separate Demand Drafts (2 nos.) for Rs. 8,000/- & Rs.69,100/- in favour of Director, SVIMS, TIRUPATI payable at Tirupati.
- 2. The candidates selected through All India Quota shall bring additional D.D for Rs.10,000/-towards University Fee.
- 3. The candidates selected under NRI category shall bring separate demand drafts (2 nos.) for USD 20,000 (US dollars) & Rs. 17,100/- in favour of Director, SVIMS, TIRUPATI payable at Tirupati.
- 4. In case, the candidate wants to cancel the admission / slide to other college (AIQ / Merit category) within the time schedule, except Rs. 8000/-, the remaining fees will be refunded.

5. If the candidate discontinues the course for any reason beyond the date of closure of admissions, she will be relieved only on payment of tuition fee for the entire course.

IV GENERAL REGULATIONS:

- 1. All admissions shall be deemed as provisional and subject to further scrutiny. They are liable for cancellation at any time during the study by reason of incorrect or false information furnished by the applicant or her parents at the time of admission. The cancellation of admission does not exclude penal action under the relevant criminal law.
- 2. The selected candidates shall undergo medical examination by the authority specified by the university. The admission is subject to their fitness.
- 3. The admitted candidates shall abide by the rules and regulations of the university laid down from time to time.
- 4. The university reserves the right to revise any of these rules without notice.
- 5. The candidate admitted for MBBS course shall not be permitted to register for any other degree/diploma/ correspondence courses concurrently.
- 6. The candidates who got admitted in to the course shall not be given the original certificates under any circumstances. They are advised to keep sufficient Xerox copies of certificates for their future use.
- 7. The students shall maintain strict discipline during the period of study/training programme in terms of conduct rules of the institute. The candidates shall not resort to any strikes during the period of their study. The students are not permitted to approach print or electronic media, legal authorities, MCI and government directly without prior permission by the head of the institution. Their grievances (if any) shall be submitted to the Principal through proper channel. In case of violation of the conduct rules, the admission of the candidate is liable for cancellation.
- 8. The selected candidates must join the course, on the date specified by DGHS as per MCC calendar. Those who do not report before the said date, their admission shall automatically stand cancelled without further notice.
- 9. Scholarship: The students who belong to SC/ST/BC/PWD/EBC/minority are eligible to get the scholarship from the respective welfare authorities of the Govt. of A.P. The eligibility of the candidate for reimbursement of fee is decided by the social welfare officer after verifying the original documents like caste, ration card, Aadhar card, income certificate etc., In case the Govt. sanction the scholarship, the difference of fee (if any) is to be paid by the student in each academic year within the last date specified. In the event of submitting wrong declaration and documents, both the student and parent are liable for legal action.

9. Hostel Accommodation:

- a. All the students who require accommodation will be provided on shared basis on a rent fixed as per rules of the institute.
- b. The Hosteller has to pay hostel mess charges, establishment charges for each academic year at a time, before commencement of the academic year. Hostel Deposit (Refundable) and Hostel Corpus fund (Non refundable) have to be paid at the time of admission to the hostel.
- c. All the students have to abide by the hostel rules that will be provided at the time of admission.
- d. The students will be responsible for proper upkeep of the furniture and other fixtures of the room. In case of damage/loss, a penalty would be imposed as assessed by the wardens of the hostels.
- e. No electrical/civil alternation in the room is allowed.
- f. Use of air conditioner/ heaters and other electrical appliances consuming high electrical energy is not permitted in the hostel.

10. Academic Facilities:

- a. The Students are provided a TAB containing e-Study material of MBBS Programme at the time of joining. They have to pay Rs.35,000/- that include the cost of the TAB and e-Content.
- b. The institute is approved by American Heart Association (AHA) to provide training in Basic Life Support (BLS) and Advanced Cardiac Life Support (ACLS) provider and instructor courses. It is mandatory for all the MBBS students to undergo BLS training programme on payment of Rs. 2500/-.

11. Ban or ragging in the campus:

Ragging, use of drugs, drug trafficking and eve teasing etc. are strictly forbidden in the university campus and persons found indulging in such activities will be subjected to strict disciplinary action as per the law. Indulging in any criminal activity within or outside the university and any physical violence against fellow students and fellow residents will not be tolerated and will attract stern disciplinary action including rustication.

As per the orders of the "Hon'ble Supreme Court of India if any incident of ragging comes to the notice of the authority of the university, the student concerned will be given liberty to explain and if her explanation is not satisfactory, the authority would expel her from the university besides making entry in her certificates to that effect. Apart from the above, the students are liable for a fine up to Rs.50,000/-, rigorous imprisonment up to three

years (by court of law), and other punishments as per the Act.No.26 of 1997, dated 21-08-1997 of State of Andhra Pradesh. The abstract of the act as per G.O.MS.No. 67, Higher Education (EC) Department, dated 31.08.2002.

A committee is constituted by the university to deal with the menace of violence and sexual harassment against women in the campus.

The disciplinary committee is constituted by the university with Principal as Chairman to examine all the disciplinary and related issues pertaining to the students. Based on the gravity of the case, the committee shall make appropriate recommendations to the Director cum VC, SVIMS.

- 12. Not with-standing anything contained therein, the Principal SVIMS, SPMC(W) may at any time before completion of the course either on his/her own motion or on the application of any person after due and proper enquiry and after giving the person two weeks time from the date of receipt of the show cause notice to submit the written explanation and on personal hearing, recommends the cancellation of admission to the Director cum VC, SVIMS.
- 13. The students shall wear the uniform for both theory and practical classes.
- 14. **Warning:** In case any candidate is found to have supplied false information or certificate or found to have withheld or concealed certain information, she shall be debarred from continuing the course and shall face such appropriate action initiated against her by the Head of the institute and her name will be referred to Medical Council of India.

V. GENERAL FACILITIES

1. TRAINING:

Sri Venkateswara Institute of Medical Sciences (SVIMS), Tirupati imparts training through attached Sri Padmavathi Medical College Hospital & super specialty hospital.

Presently, both hospitals together have 1098 beds providing services to the patients. For the year 2017, 5,68,108 out patients visited, 40,138 in-patients were admitted and 10,756 patients underwent surgeries in both the hospitals. The Institute performed 20,98,996 investigations.

SVIMS ensures that teaching methods employed, facilities and content of the programs are in line with the latest innovations with a strong science base. The Institute promotes teaching and training through seminars, didactic lectures and wide range of clinical and laboratory experiences, independent thinking and relevant research.

The students are provided hands on training in the State-of-Art equipments available in the Institute under the supervision of senior technologists and faculty. They are not permitted to

handle the equipment and patients independently. In the event of causing damage to the equipment or accessories or misbehaving with the patients will lead to stern disciplinary action apart from recovery of the damage caused.

2. Library:

There is a well established separate library building in 45000 sq.ft. available in SVIMS Campus with good collection of books (10000+) and subscription of foreign and Indian journals (179). The library has back volume journal collection from the year 1993. The library is having internet facility with static IP address with 10 mbps speed for the use of faculty and post graduate students. It has Scanning and Photocopying facilities for library users. The Library is kept open for 363 days in a year except Jan 26th and Aug 15th and functions 16 hours a day i.e. 9 A.M. to 12 A.M. (Midnight). During festivals, holidays and Sundays, it works from 10 A.M. to5
