I. INTRODUCTION:

Sri Venkateswara Institute of Medical Sciences (SVIMS), Tirupati, established in the year 1993, under the aegis of TirumalaTirupatiDevasthanams, as a modern super speciality hospital, became a university in the year 1995 by an act of A.P. state legislature vide act no.12 of 1995. The objectives of the institute are:

- a) to create a centre of excellence for providing medical care, education and research facilities of a high order in the field of medical sciences in the existing super-specialities and such other super-specialities as may develop in future, including continuing medical education and hospital administration.
- b) To develop patterns of teaching in undergraduate &
- c) postgraduate level and in super specialities so as to set a high standard of medical education.
- d) To provide for training in paramedical and allied fields, particularly in relation to super-specialities.
- e) To function as a referral hospital.
- f) To provide for post graduate teaching and conduct of research in the relevant disciplines of modern medicine and other allied sciences, including inter-disciplinary fields of physical and biological sciences.

The institution, spread in a 107.04 acre campus, has 38 super/broad speciality medical departments, three constituent colleges and is a centre of excellence providing medical care, education and research activities of a high standard in the field of medical and other allied sciences. SVIMS also provides training in para-medical and allied fields.

The Institution is recognized by the University Grants Commission (UGC) under section 12 (B) of the UGC act, 1956, and Medical Council of India (MCI) has granted permission and later recognition to start DM/M.Ch. super-speciality courses in Cardiology, Neurology, Nephrology, Endocrinology, Medical Oncology, Cardiothoracic Surgery, Neurosurgery, Urology, Surgical Oncology, Surgical Gastroenterology and PG Medical (MD) courses in Anaesthesiology, Emergency Medicine, Microbiology, Nuclear Medicine, Biochemistry, Pathology, Medicine, ImmunoHaematology & Blood Transfusion, Radio Diagnosis and Radiotherapy. The latest addition is MBBS course started from 2014-2015.

The constituent colleges are:

- 1) **SVIMS, Sri Padmavathi Medical College for Women (SPMC-W)** :The college was permitted by Govt. of India for admitting MBBS students with 150 annual intake w.e.f. 2014-15 academic year is recognized by the Govt. of India. This college is meant exclusively for women. The intake of seats are increased from 150 to 175 w.e.f 2019-20 a.y.
- 2) **College of nursing:** The college of nursing was established in the year 1996, with the objective of providing graduate, postgraduate teaching and for conduct of research in the relevant disciplines of modern nursing. Courses offered are B.Sc. (nursing), M.Sc. (nursing) and Ph.D. The college has excellent infrastructure with well equipped laboratories, advanced teaching and learning facilities.
- 3) **College of physiotherapy:** The College of physiotherapy was established in the year 1998. The college offers graduate and postgraduate courses in physiotherapy, in-patient and outpatient services and special services through obesity pain, paediatric clinics, advanced physiotherapy, ergonomics & life style modification.

The other interdisciplinary departments are;

- 1) **Biotechnology:** The department of Biotechnology established in 2003, is offering M.Sc. Biotechnology with intake of 15 students per annum and Ph.D. programmes. The successful students are absorbed in industrial organizations, who are leaders in production of drugs, vaccines, etc. They have also been in various national level examinations like CSIR, GATE, ICMR, BCIL (biotechnology consortium India Ltd., New Delhi).
- 2) **Bioinformatics:** The Department of Bioinformatics established in 2003, is offering M.Sc. Bioinformatics with intake of 15 students per annum and Ph.D. programmes. The students are selected in various National level examinations like GATE, ICMR, Bioinformatics Industrial Training Programme, New Delhi (BIITP). The successful students are absorbed in industrial organizations, and software companies. The DBT, ministry of science and technology, Govt. of India has sanctioned the Bioinformatics centre to support teaching and research work. The Bioinformatics infrastructure facility was housed in the Department of Bioinformatics. The Bioinformatics centre offers two studentships for final semester M.Sc Bioinformatics students and two traineeships for M.Sc Bioinformatics students every year. The students selected under this scheme are awarded a stipend of Rs 8,000/- per month for a period of sixmonths.

MBBS COURSE

I. Distribution of seats (Total 175) :

1. **All India Quota :**15% seats (26) are filled by the Medical Counseling committee (MCC), DGHS, Govt. of India. For details of counseling schedule, please refer to MCC web site : (www.mcc.nic.in)
2. **State Quota (Merit Category):** 70% seats (126) are filled by Dr NTRUHS, Vijayawada. For details of counseling schedule, please refer to DR NTRUHS website: (www.drntruhs.ac.in)
3. **NRI Category :** 23 Seats are filled by Dr NTRUHS, Vijayawada. For details of counseling schedule, please refer to DR NTRUHS web site : (www.drntruhs.ac.in)

Note: The admissions are not conducted directly by SVIMS university for any of the seats in the above categories.

II. ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION:

1. The general eligibility conditions as notified by Dr NTRUHS shall be followed.
2. The women candidates are only eligible from AP origin
3. Additionally the eligibility condition for NRI/NRI sponsored category shall be satisfied as detailed below
4. **NRI Category:** The candidates who are claiming under NRI category shall satisfying the following:
 - i. Applicant shall be the ward of NRI or NRI citizen by herself.
 - ii. The NRI parent shall be
 - (a) Holding the OCI/PIO/Permanent citizenship status with AP origin.
 - (b) Employment in abroad.
 - (c) Shall have the annual income sufficient to support the course of study of his/her ward.
5. **NRI sponsored Category:**

In the event of non-availability of adequate number of eligible NRI candidates, NRI sponsored candidates will be considered subject to fulfillment of the following:

- a. The sponsor shall be blood relation to the applicant i.e. father, mother, brother or their children, sister or their children, maternal uncle or his children, maternal aunt or her children, paternal uncle or his children, paternal aunt or her children, maternal grandfather, maternal grandmother, paternal grandfather and paternal grandmother. The genealogical tree certificate (or) equivalent issued by the Tahsildar and above, for establishing the relationship of the sponsor and the applicant.
- b. NRI status certificate issued by the Indian embassy under seal (or) overseas citizen of India (OCI) (or) PIO status certificate issued by the competent authority.
- c. Copy of the passport with valid visa.
- d. The sponsor with student / visiting visa or temporary visa of any nature is **not eligible to sponsor**.
- e. Shall have the annual income sufficient to support the course of study of his/her ward

III. Documents to be submitted along with the application and at time of counselling :

1. NRI category:

- (a) NEET rank card
- (b) Qualifying examination marks memo
- (c) If studied abroad, equivalent certificate from recognized board in India
- (d) Proof of date of birth and place of birth.

- (e) School or college leaving certificate (transfer certificate) from the institution last studied.
- (f) Study certificate from VI class to intermediate/equivalent.
- (g) Citizenship status of the candidate.
- (h) Declaration (Annexure) by the candidate and NRI Parent in Rs.20/- Non-Judicial stamp paper as per Dr.NTRUHS Proforma mentioned in their Prospectus

Documents to be furnished by NRI parent

- (i) Recent NRI status certificate of the parent issued by the respective embassy with their seal or OCI/ PIO/ Permanent citizenship certificate from the competent authority.
- (j) Copy of recent NRI bank account details.
- (k) Employment certificate of NRI parent. In case of self-employment, nature of business, annual income and proof thereof to be furnished and copy of the income tax returns filed for the previous financial year.

2. NRI sponsored category:

- (a) NEET rank card
- (b) Intermediate marks memo
- (c) Transfer certificate
- (d) SSC Certificate
- (e) Study certificate from Class 6th to 12th standard
- (f) Genealogical tree certificate or equivalent issued by Tahsildar and above

Documents of NRI sponsor to be submitted:

- (g) NRI status certificate (Citizenship/Residence or equivalent)
- (h) Copy of the passport with valid visa
- (i) Copy of recent NRI bank account details.
- (j) Employment certificate
- (k) Declaration (Annexure) by the candidate and NRI Sponsor in Rs.20/- Non-Judicial stamp paper as per Dr.NTRUHS Proforma mentioned in their Prospectus.

IV. SELECTION CRITERIA:

- (i) A separate merit list will be prepared for NRI and NRI sponsored category by the Dr NTRUHS basing on the rank secured in the NEET examination.
- (ii) After all the NRI category (NEET qualified & eligible) candidates get admitted, the remaining vacancies shall be filled with NRI sponsored category.

V. REPORTING FOR ADMISSION:

The selected candidates have to report at Sri Padmavathi Medical College for Women with the original documents specified above along with the following additional original documents.

- 8) S.S.C.Certificate
- 9) Inter Bi.PC Marks list (or) equivalent certificate.
- 10) Transfer certificate.
- 11) Study certificate from 6th class to intermediate.
- 12) Declaration by the candidate and NRI Parent / Guardian in Rs.20/- Non-Judicial stamp paper as per Dr.NTRUHS Proforma mentioned in their Prospectus.

1. The candidates selected shall bring separate demand drafts (2 nos.) for 20,000 US dollars (or) equivalent in Indian Rupees as per the prevailing market rate of US Dollar on the day of payment and Rs. 17,100/- in favour of The Director, SVIMS, TIRUPATI payable at Tirupati.
2. In case, the candidate wants to cancel the admission / slide to other college within the final round of counseling, 10% of Tuition fee (+GST) will be deducted and the balance fee will be refunded.
3. If the candidate discontinues the course for any reason beyond the date of closure of admissions, she will be relieved only on payment of the tuition fee for the entire course (+GST, if applicable).

VII. GENERAL REGULATIONS:

1. All admissions shall be deemed as provisional and subject to further scrutiny. They are liable for cancellation at any time during the study by reason of incorrect or false information furnished by the applicant or her parents at the time of admission. The cancellation of admission does not exclude penal action under the relevant criminal law.
2. The selected candidates shall undergo medical examination by the authority specified by the university. The admission is subject to their fitness.
3. The admitted candidates shall abide by the rules and regulations of the university laid down from time to time.
4. The university reserves the right to revise any of these rules without notice.
5. The candidate admitted for MBBS course shall not be permitted to register for any other degree/diploma/ correspondence courses concurrently.
6. The candidates who got admitted in to the course shall not be given the original certificates under any circumstances. They are advised to keep sufficient Xerox copies of certificates for their future use.
7. The students shall maintain strict discipline during the period of study/training programme in terms of conduct rules of the institute. The candidates shall not resort to any strikes during the period of their study. The students are not permitted to approach print or electronic media, legal authorities, MCI and government directly without prior permission by the head of the institution. Their grievances (if any) shall be submitted to the Principal through proper channel. In case of violation of the conduct rules, the admission of the candidate is liable for cancellation.
8. The selected candidates must join the course, on the date specified by DGHS as per MCC calendar. Those who do not report before the said date, their admission shall automatically stand cancelled without further notice.

9. Hostel Accommodation:

- a. All the students who require accommodation will be provided on shared basis on a rent fixed as per rules of the institute.
- b. The Hosteller has to pay hostel mess charges, establishment charges for each academic year periodically as notified. Hostel Deposit of Rs.5,000/- (Refundable) and Hostel Corpus fund of Rs.5,000/- (Non refundable) have to be paid at the time of admission to the hostel.
- c. All the students have to abide by the hostel rules that will be provided at the time of admission.
- d. The students will be responsible for proper upkeep of the furniture and other fixtures of the room. In case of damage/loss, a penalty would be imposed as assessed by the wardens of the hostels.
- e. No electrical/civil alternation in the room is allowed.
- f. Use of air conditioner/ heaters and other electrical appliances consuming high electrical energy is not permitted in the hostel.

10. Academic Facilities:

- a. A TAB containing e-Study material of MBBS Programme will be provided to all the students on payment basis. They have to pay the stipulated amount that include the cost of the TAB and e-Content. The amount to be paid will be decided later and the students will be intimated the cost of TAB with e-study material. This is compulsory for all the students.
- b. The institute is approved by American Heart Association (AHA) to provide training in Basic Life Support (BLS) and Advanced Cardiac Life Support (ACLS) provider and instructor courses. It is mandatory for all the MBBS students to undergo BLS training programme on payment of Rs.2500/-.

11. Ban or ragging in the campus:

Ragging, use of drugs, drug trafficking and eve teasing etc. are strictly forbidden in the university campus and persons found indulging in such activities will be subjected to strict disciplinary action as per the law. Indulging in any criminal activity within or outside the university and any physical violence against fellow students and fellow residents will not be tolerated and will attract stern disciplinary action including rustication.

As per the orders of the “Hon’ble Supreme Court of India if any incident of ragging comes to the notice of the authority of the university, the student concerned will be given liberty to explain and if her explanation is not satisfactory, the authority would expel her from the university besides making entry in her certificates to that effect. Apart from the above, the students are liable for a fine upto Rs.50,000/-, rigorous imprisonment up to three years (by court of law), and other punishments as per the Act.No.26 of 1997, dated 21-08- 1997 of State of Andhra Pradesh. The abstract of the act as per G.O.MS.No. 67, Higher Education (EC) Department, dated 31.08.2002.

A committee is constituted by the university to deal with the menace of violence and sexual harassment against women in the campus.

The disciplinary committee is constituted by the university with Principal as Chairman to examine all the disciplinary and related issues pertaining to the students. Based on the gravity of the case, the committee shall make appropriate recommendations to the Director cum VC, SVIMS.

12. Not with-standing anything contained therein, the Principal SVIMS, SPMC(W) may at any time before completion of the course either on his/her own motion or on the application of any person after due and proper enquiry and after giving the person two weeks time from the date of receipt of the show cause notice to submit the written explanation and on personal hearing, recommends the cancellation of admission to the Director cum VC,SVIMS.
13. The students shall wear the uniform for both theory and practical classes.
14. **Warning:** In case any candidate is found to have supplied false information or certificate or found to have withheld or concealed certain information, she shall be debarred from continuing the course and shall face such appropriate action initiated against her by the Head of the institute and her name will be referred to Medical Council of India.

15. Library :

There is a well established separate library building in 45000 sq.ft. available in SVIMS Campus with good collection of books (11000+) and subscription of foreign and Indian journals (159). The library has back volume journal collection from the year 1993. The library is having internet facility with static IP address with 10 mbps speed for the use of faculty and post graduate students. It has Scanning and Photocopying facilities for library users. The Library is kept open for 363 days in a year except Jan 26th and Aug 15th and functions 16 hours a day i.e. 9 A.M. to 12 A.M. (Midnight). During festivals, holidays and Sundays, it works from 10 A.M. to 5 P.M.

16. Games and sports:

The institute is promoting the sports and games culture among the student community by organizing coaching camps in various disciplines for the University teams. The university is member of Association of Indian universities (AIU) and students are encouraged to participate in Inter university Zonal and All India level Tournaments regular. Further, the University organizes annual competitions to inspire the student community to involve in sports and games to improve their health status.
