Admission guidelines for MBBS students for the AY 2022-23 (AIQ Category)

- I. The student has to submit the following documents in original at the verification counter:
 - 1) Provisional admission order from MCC, DGHS, Govt. of India
 - 2) NEET Hall Ticket -2022
 - 3) NEET 2022 RANK CARD
 - 4) Filled in Application (to be provided at our Medical College Counter on the date of reporting)
 - 5) S.S.C. or its equivalent examination showing the date of birth.
 - 6) Intermediate Bi.PC Marks list.
 - 7) Transfer certificate.
 - 8) Study certificate from 6th class to intermediate (or) Residence certificate of the candidate / parents
 - 9) Migration Certificate
 - 10) Copy of the Aadhar Card
 - 11) Caste certificate. (For BC, SC, ST categories only)
 - 12) Online undertaking/affidavit on anti-ragging.*
 - 13) Passport size photographs –4.
 - 14) Stamp size photographs -2.
 - 15) Joint affidavit to be executed by Parent & Student on Non-Judicial stamp paper worth of Rs.20/-

II. Payment of fee by way of DDs in the name of Director, SVIMS, Tirupati as follows:

- i) Tuition & other fees receipt
 - a) Two demand drafts for Rs.8,000(non refundable) & Rs. 69,100/- (refundable).
 - If candidate wants to cancel admission / slide to other college within the time schedule, except Rs.8,000/- the remaining fees will be refunded and also as per latest GST guidelines, the candidate has to pay GST@18% i.e., Rs. 1,440/-.
- ii) Towards university fee Rs.10,500/-
- iii) Caution deposit (Refundable) Rs. 5,000/-
- iv) Special Fees:
 - a) BLS Training Rs. 3,200/-
- v) Hostel deposit (for those staying in the hostel) Rs.10,000-00
 - (Rs. 5,000-00 Refundable and Rs.5,000 Non-refundable)

For hostel accommodation enquire in the counter with warden/matron and follow the hostel norms.

- III. The candidate has to report on or before the date specified by MCC, DGHS, Govt. of India with the above documents, failing which their admission stands cancelled.
- IV. As per MCI/NMC Schedule, the classes will be commenced and hence, the students are informed to join the college as per the schedule and they are advised to come with all the required luggage. The hostel accommodation will be provided on the day of reporting.
- V. After submitting all the documents, payment of all fees the admission order will be issued which is to be shown to the Heads of the departments (Anatomy, Physiology and Biochemistry) for attending classes.
