I. INTRODUCTION:

Sri Venkateswara Institute of Medical Sciences (SVIMS), Tirupati, established in the year 1993, under the aegis of Tirumala Tirupati Devasthanams, as a modern super specialty hospital, became a university in the year 1995 by an Act of A.P. State Legislature vide Act No.12 of 1995. The objectives of the institute are:

- a) To create a centre of excellence for providing medical care, education and research facilities of a high order in the field of medical sciences in the existing super- specialties/ Broad Specialties and such other specialties as may develop in future, including continuing medical education and hospital administration.
- b) To develop patterns of teaching in undergraduate & Post graduate level and in super specialties so as to set a high standard of medical education.
- c) To provide training in paramedical and allied fields, particularly in relation to super-specialties.
- d) To function as a referral hospital.
- e) To provide post graduate teaching and conduct of research in the relevant disciplines of modern medicine and other allied sciences, including inter-disciplinary fields of physical and biological sciences.

The institution, spread across a 107.04 acre campus, has 38 super/broad specialty medical departments, four constituent colleges and is a centre of excellence providing medical care, education and research activities of a high standard in the field of medical and other allied sciences. SVIMS also provides training in para-medical and allied fields.

The Institution is recognized by the University Grants Commission (UGC) under section 12 (B) of the UGC act, 1956 and Medical Council of India (MCI) has granted permission and later recognition to start PG courses such as super specialty courses (DM/MCh) in Cardiology, Neurology, Nephrology, Endocrinology, Medical Oncology, Cardiothoracic Surgery, Neurosurgery, Urology, Surgical Oncology, Surgical Gastroenterology and Broad specialty (MD/MS) courses in Anesthesiology, Emergency Medicine, Microbiology, Nuclear Medicine, Biochemistry, Pathology, Medicine, Immuno Haematology & Blood Transfusion, Radio Diagnosis, Radiotherapy. Anatomy, Physiology, Pharmacology, Community Medicine and General Surgery. Sri Padmavathi Medical College for Women for U.G.(MBBS) was started from the A.Y. 2014-2015 and the course was recognized by MCI(NMC) vide Endst. No. MCI-34(41)(R-6)/2018-Med./187199 dated 13-03-2019.

The constituent colleges are:

- 1) **SVIMS-Sri Padmavathi Medical College for Women (SPMCW) :** The college was permitted by Govt. of India for admitting MBBS students with 150 annual intake w.e.f. 2014-15 academic year and is recognized by the Govt. of India vide notification [No.U.12012/109/2019-ME.I (FTS.3205037)] dated 01-04-2019. The intake was enhanced by allotment of 25 seats under 10% EWS Quota i.e. from 150 to 175 w.e.f. 2019-20.
- 2) **College of Nursing:** The college of Nursing was established in the year 1996, with the objective of providing graduate, postgraduate teaching and for research in the relevant disciplines of modern nursing. The courses offered are B.Sc. (Nursing) with 110 seats, M.Sc. (Nursing) with 33 seats including EWS and Ph.D. Programme.
- 3) **College of Physiotherapy:** The College of physiotherapy was established in the year 1998. The college offers BPT, MPT & Ph.D. courses in physiotherapy, in-patient and outpatient services and special services through obesity clinic, pain clinic, paediatrics clinic, advanced physiotherapy, ergonomics & life style modification. There are 55 seats in BPT and 27 seats in MPT after implementation of 10% EWS Quota.

- 4) **Allied Health Sciences:** The University started paramedical Diploma courses w.e.f. 1995-96 academic year for science graduates. The duration of the course was 02 years and on completion, a PG Diploma was awarded, which has got the recognition of Andhra Pradesh Paramedical Board. Later B.Sc. Paramedical courses with 03 years duration were started w.e.f. 2009-10 academic year in 08 specialities. Now, 10 specialities are running from the a.y. 2015 onwards. From 2015-16 onwards the duration of the course was changed from 3 years to 4 years. The courses are recognized by AP Paramedical Board.

The other interdisciplinary departments are;

- 1) **Biotechnology:** The department of Biotechnology, established in 2003, is offering M.Sc. Biotechnology with intake of 17 (including EWS) students per annum and Ph.D. programmes. The successful students are absorbed in industrial organizations, who are leaders in production of drugs, vaccines etc. The students have also been selected in various national level examinations like CSIR, GATE, ICMR, BCIL (biotechnology consortium India Ltd., New Delhi).
- 2) **Bioinformatics:** The Department of Bioinformatics, established in 2003, is offering M.Sc. Bioinformatics with intake of 17 (including EWS) students per annum and Ph.D. programmes. The students are selected in various National level examinations like GATE, ICMR, Bioinformatics Industrial Training Programme, New Delhi (BIITP). The successful students are absorbed in industrial organizations, and software companies. The DBT, Ministry of Science and Technology, Govt. of India has sanctioned the Bioinformatics centre to support teaching and research work. The Bioinformatics infrastructure facility was housed in the Department of Bioinformatics. The Bioinformatics centre offers two studentships for final semester M.Sc Bioinformatics students and two traineeships for M.Sc Bioinformatics students every year. The students selected under this scheme are awarded a stipend of Rs 8,000/- per month for a period of six months.

II. Admission Process:

- 1) **All India Quota :** 26 seats shall be filled by the Medical Counseling committee (MCC), DGHS, Govt. of India. For details of counseling schedule refer to MCC website : www.mcc.nic.in
- 2) **State Quota (Merit Category):** 126 seats shall be filled by Dr .NTRUHS, Vijayawada. For details of counseling schedule refer to DR NTRUHS website: <https://drntr.uhsap.in/index/>
- 3) **NRI Category:** 23 seats shall be filled by Dr .NTRUHS, Vijayawada. For details of counselschedule. (please refer to DR NTRUHS website: <https://drntr.uhsap.in/index/>

Note: *The admissions are not conducted directly by SVIMS University for any of the seats in the above categories.*

- 1 **VENUE FOR REPORTING:** The Selected candidates after generating the allotment order from MCC, DGHS shall report at the Office of the Principal, SVIMS-SRI PADMAVATHI MEDICAL COLLEGE FOR WOMEN, SVIMS campus, TIRUPATI by the due date and time as prescribed in the order. Those who do not report by the due date and time as notified by the counselling authority, will forfeit their seat automatically, without further notice.

- 1) The Candidates selected under **Merit category** should pay fee of Rs. 95,800/- through <https://svims.digiicampus.com/home>
- 2) **AIQ category: Amount to be forfeited:** During 1,2,3 round of counselling an amount of Rs. 8000 is deducted and the remaining fee will be returned.
 - After the stay vacancy round: if the seat is going to be wasted due to discontinuation, the candidate has to pay the entire course fee.
- 3) If the candidate discontinues the course for any reason beyond the date of closure of admissions, she will be relieved only on payment of the tuition fee for the entire course
- 4) Examination fee, Fees for issue of various certificates are extra to be borne by the student.

III GENERAL REGULATIONS:

- 1) All admissions shall be deemed as provisional and subject to further scrutiny. They are liable for cancellation at any time during the study for the reason of incorrect or false information furnished by the applicant or her parents at the time of admission. The cancellation of admission does not exclude penal action under the relevant criminal law.
- 2) The selected candidate shall undergo medical examination by the authority specified by the university. The admission is subject to their fitness.
- 3) The admitted candidate shall abide by the rules and regulations of the university laid down from time to time.
- 4) The university reserves the right to revise any of these rules without notice.
- 5) The candidates admitted for MBBS course shall not be permitted to register for any other degree/diploma/ correspondence courses concurrently.
- 6) The candidate who got admission into the course shall not be given the original certificates under any circumstances until course is completed and full fees are paid. They are advised to keep sufficient Xerox copies of certificates for their future use.
- 7) The students shall maintain strict discipline during the period of study/training programme in terms of conduct rules of the institute. The candidates shall not resort to any strikes during the period of their study and during Internship period. The students are not permitted to approach print or electronic media, legal authorities, NMC and government directly without prior permission by the head of the institution. Their grievances (if any) shall be submitted to the Principal through proper channel. In case of violation of the conduct rules, the admission of the candidate is liable for cancellation.
- 8) The selected candidates must join the course, on the date specified by DGHS as per MCC calendar. Those who do not report before the said date, their admission shall automatically stand cancelled without further notice.
- 9) **Scholarship:** The students who belong to SC/ST/BC/PWD/EBC/minority are eligible to get the scholarship from the respective welfare authorities of the Govt. of A.P / India. The eligibility of the candidate for reimbursement of fee is decided by the welfare authority after verifying the original documents like caste, ration card, Aadhar card, income certificate etc., In case the Govt. sanction the scholarship, the difference of fee (if any) to be paid by the student in each academic year by the last date specified. In the event of submission of wrong declaration and documents, both the student and parent are liable for legal action.

10) Hostel Accommodation:

- a. 100% accommodation is not possible to all students, which will be provided on first come first basis, subject to availability.
- b. Accommodation will be provided on single/shared basis on a rent fixed as per fee rules & regulations of the institute from time to time, subject to availability.
 - At present Room rent per month is Rs. 2600/- for single and Rs.1300/- for shared.
 - Room rent per month is Rs. 5000/- for single with attached washroom and Geyser
- c. The Hosteller has to pay hostel establishment charges for each academic year periodically as notified.
- d. The Hosteller has to pay Hostel room rent for one year (12 Months) as advance at the time of joining the Hostel. Further, Hostel Deposit of Rs.5,000/- (Refundable) and Hostel Corpus fund of Rs.5,000/- (Non refundable) have to be paid at the time of joining the hostel.
- e. The inmates are advised to go through the Hostel Rules and Regulations given in SVIMS website under Medical College Tab.
- f. No electrical/civil alternation in the room is allowed.
- g. Use of air conditioner / heaters and other electrical appliances consuming high electrical energy is not permitted in the hostel and punishable if violated.
- h. Passport size photo of Father, Mother, Student and local guardian to be submitted by the student at the time reporting at Hostel.

11) Academic Facilities:

- a. The institute is approved by American Heart Association (AHA) to provide training in Basic Life Support (BLS) and Advanced Cardiac Life Support (ACLS) provider and instructor courses. It is mandatory for all the MBBS students to undergo BLS training programme on payment of Rs.3200/-.

12) Medical Conditions not eligible for Admission:

Admission to the programme for the year is subject to being found medically fit by the Medical Board of SVIMS.

The candidate with the following diseases will not be eligible for admission as it would interfere with the successful completion of the course.

- Any form of cancer
- Uncontrolled hypertension
- Psychiatric mental disorders
- Renal failure
- Cardiac conditions that limit normal daily activities
- Major orthopedic deformities
- Severe loss of hearing
- Severe eczema
- Color blindness
- And any other conditions which as certified by the medical board of the University would interfere with the successful completion of the course.
- Any chronic illness or treatment taken prior should be declared at the time of admission. Failure to do so may lead to dismissal from the course.

The student has to disclose her illness/s, either past or present, voluntarily in the application

failing which, her admission will stand cancelled and the fees remitted will not be refunded at any cost. If found suffering with the diseases above during the course of study she will be expelled from the university.

13) Ban or ragging in the campus:

Ragging, use of drugs, drug trafficking and eve teasing etc., are strictly forbidden in the university campus and persons found indulging in such activities will be subjected to strict disciplinary action as per the law. Indulging in any criminal activity within or outside the university and any physical violence against fellow students and fellow residents will not be tolerated and will attract stern disciplinary action including rustication.

As per the orders of the “Hon’ble Supreme Court of India if any incident of ragging comes to the notice of the authority of the university, the student concerned will be given liberty to explain and if her explanation is not satisfactory, the authority would expel her from the university besides making entry in her certificates to that effect. Apart from the above, the students are liable for a fine up to Rs.50,000/-, rigorous imprisonment up to three years (by court of law), and other punishments as per the Act.No.26 of 1997, dated 21-08- 1997 of State of Andhra Pradesh. The abstract of the act is as per G.O.MS.No. 67, Higher Education (EC) Department, dated 31.08.2002.

A committee is constituted by the university to deal with the menace of violence and sexual harassment against women in the campus.

The disciplinary committee is constituted by the university with Principal as Chairman to examine all the discipline and related issues pertaining to the students. Based on the gravity of the case, the committee shall make appropriate recommendations to the Director cum VC, SVIMS.

14) Not with-standing anything contained therein, the Principal SVIMS-SPMCW may at any time before completion of the course either on his/her own motion or on the complaint from any person after due and proper enquiry and after giving the person two weeks of time from the date of issue of the show cause notice to submit the written explanation and on personal hearing, if not satisfied can recommend the cancellation of admission of the student to the Director cum VC, SVIMS.

15) The students shall wear the uniform for both theory and practical classes. It is mandatory for all students to wear the prescribed college uniform as per SVIMS University regulations. No dress specific to any religion shall be permitted. Students who do not conform to the uniform regulations will NOT be permitted in college premises and strict disciplinary action will be taken against them.

- 16) **Warning:** In case any candidate is found to have submitted false information or certificate or found to have withheld or concealed certain information, she shall be debarred from continuing the course and shall face such appropriate action initiated against her by the Head of the institute and her name will be referred to NMC.

17) Library:

There is a well-established library with a collection of 23445 books with subscription for 144 print journals (85 foreign and 59 Indian). It has a back volume journal collection of 8560 dating back to 1993. The Library is having membership in National Medical Library, New Delhi and One Nation and One subscription (ONOS) provided by the INFLIBNET, Gujarat. It is having e-library facility with 25 nodes for browsing internet for the use of faculty, P.G. and U.G. students. Library is kept open for 363 days in a year except on January, 26th and August 15th and functions 16 hours a day i.e. 8.00 A.M. to 12.00 Midnight. During festival holidays and Sundays, library is kept open from 10.00 A.M to 5.00 P.M. All the library services are automated by adopting KOHA library automation software.

The National medical Library, New Delhi providing membership in ERMED consortium to access 228+ e-journals with back issues and One Nation and One subscription (ONOS) provided 1700+ E-journals with free of cost.

18) Games and sports:

The institute promotes the sports and games and cultural activities among the student community by organizing coaching camps in various disciplines for the University teams. The university is member of Association of Indian universities (AIU) and students are encouraged to participate in Inter University Zonal and All India level Tournaments regularly. Further, the University organizes annual competitions to inspire the student community to involve in sports and games to improve their well being.
