Sub.: Increase of seats in Postgraduate Medical courses in view of increase of allocation of seats as per teachers students ratio- Sri Venkateswara Institute of Medical Sciences, Tirupati.

Sir,

I am directed to state that the Post Graduate Committee of this Council at its meeting held on 29.12.2009 considered the information received from the various Government medical colleges / institutions with regard to number of Professors, No. of Units & bed strength in each Post Graduate Speciality together with the Central Government Gazette notification dated 24/07/2009 regarding amendments in clause 12(1), (2), (3) & (4) of the Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations 2000. The committee decided as under which I am directed to convey herewith for your information and necessary action in the matter.

"The Postgraduate Committee considered the Central Government Gazette notification dated 24/07/2009 regarding amendments in clause 12(1), (2), (3) & (4) of the Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations 2000 and noted the following:-

1. The ratio of recognized postgraduate teacher to the number of students to be admitted for the degree course where diploma is not prescribed shall be 1:2 for a Professor and 1:1 for other cadres in each unit per year subject to a maximum of 4 PG seats for the degree per unit per academic year provided a complement of 10 teaching beds is added to the prescribed bed strength of 30 for the unit for broad specialities.
2. The ratio of recognized postgraduate teacher to the number of students to be admitted for the degree course in broad specialities where diploma is prescribed shall be 1:2 for a Professor and 1:1 for other cadres in each unit per year subject to a maximum of 4 PG seats including diploma per unit per academic year provided a complement of 10 teaching beds is added to the prescribed bed strength of 30 for the unit.
3. The requirement of units and beds shall not apply in the case of Postgraduate degree or diploma courses in Basic and para-clinical departments.
Provided that against the very same units, teaching-personnel and infrastructure, no other postgraduate courses under any other streams like National Board of Examinations, College of Physicians & Surgeons etc. are permitted.
4. The ratio of PG teacher to the number of students to be admitted for super specialities course shall be 1:2 for Professor/Assoc. Professor and 1:1 for remaining cadre in each unit per year subject to a maximum of 4 PG seats for the course per unit per academic year provided the complement of 10 teaching beds per seat is added to the prescribed bed strength of 20 for the unit."

Provided that against the very same units, teaching personnel and infrastructure, no other postgraduate courses under any other streams like National Board of Examinations, College of Physicians & Surgeons etc. are permitted.

Accordingly a circular was sent by the Council Office to the Health Secretaries of all the states on 15/09/2009 and 24/09/2009 requesting to direct the Deans/Principals to send the information as regards availability of Professors in the subjects of broad specialties and availability of Professors and Assoc Professors in respect of super specialties and also unit wise number of teaching beds and students.

The Committee taking into consideration the Gazette Notification dated 24.07.2009 and the information furnished by the college / institution authority regarding availability of Professors in the concerned department and decided to enhance the number of post graduate seats in various super / broad specialties courses as mentioned against each at Sri Venkateswara Institute of Medical Sciences, Tirupati from the academic year 2010-2011."

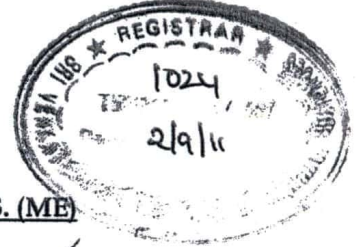

Sub: Starting of MD(Radio-therapy) course at Sri Venkateswara Institute of Medical Sciences, Tirupati under Sri Venkateshwara Institute of Medical Sciences, (Deemed University), Tirupati u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 -Permission of Board of Governors- regarding.

Sir/Madam,

In continuation to this office Letter of Intent dated 19th March, 2012, I am directed to convey the Conditional Permission of Board of Governor for Starting of MD(Radio-therapy) course with annual intake of 2(Two) students per year with prospective effect, from the academic session 2012-13 at your Institute/college u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

This Letter of Permission is subject to fulfillment of the following conditions:-

1. The applicant should provide all infrastructural facilities in terms of teaching and non-teaching staff, buildings, equipment and hospital facilities as per Medical Council of India norms. I am further directed to inform that you and your institution are fully responsible to fulfill and maintain norms including the infrastructure both physical and human resource, teaching faculty and clinical material, etc. throughout the academic year, as stipulated in Postgraduate Regulation of Medical Council of India. In case false/wrong declaration or fabricated documents have been used for procuring permission of the Board of Governors for the starting/increased intake and the said misconduct is brought to notice or comes to the knowledge of Medical Council of India at any stage during the current academic year, your institution is not liable to be considered for increased intake for the next academic year and this letter of permission for the increased intake/starting is also liable to be revoked for current academic year. Besides, Medical Council of India is entitled to take all such measures against you and your college/institution as permissible under the law.
2. Other deficiencies if any pointed out in the inspection report should be rectified. A copy of MCI inspection report is enclosed.
3. No student should be admitted in the above courses till the formal permission of the Board of Governors is granted.
4. The applicant should provide Bank Guarantee of required amount wherever required in favour of Secretary, Medical Council of India, New Delhi valid for three years from a nationalized/scheduled Bank as per MCI's norms against increased intake/starting of above said course. However, Bank guarantee is not applicable for Government institution.
5. The college has to give an undertaking that the students admitted to this course shall be paid stipend on par with the stipend being paid to the Postgraduate students of State Government Medical Institutes/Central Government Medical Institutions, in the State/Union Territory where the institution is located as required under Clause 13.3 of the Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations.
6. Postgraduate students admitted to this course would be required to present one poster presentation to read one paper at a national/state conference and to present one research paper which should be published/accepted for publication/sent for publication during the period of his Postgraduate studies so as to make him eligible to appear at the Postgraduate

degree examination as prescribed in the Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations notified vide Gazette Notification dated 09/12/2009 (Clause 13.9).

7. As per Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations under Clause 14.(4)(a) it has been prescribed that "Every candidate shall carry out work on an assigned research project under the guidance of a recognized Post Graduate Teacher, the result of which shall be written up and submitted in the form of a Thesis. The thesis shall be examined by a minimum of three examiners; one internal and two external examiners, who shall not be the examiners for Theory and Clinical examination. A candidate shall be allowed to appear for the Theory and Practical/Clinical examination only after the acceptance of the Thesis by the examiners."
8. The Medical college while making admission to the course shall ensure that:-
- No admission is permitted beyond the sanctioned intake capacity.
 - Selection of students to the Medical College is in accordance with the requirements laid down in the Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations, 1997.
 - No admission is permitted beyond the cutoff date

It shall be incumbent upon the Medical College that the information relating to admission should be submitted within a fortnight of closure of admission to the Council. Any failure to submit the information within this time limit would be construed that the admission in the College were not in accordance with the statutory requirements, thereby enabling the Council to proceed in accordance with law against the college.

You are requested to send compliance to above mentioned conditions including bank guarantee as required under the Regulations of Medical Council of India within **15(Fifteen) days** of issue of this letter failing which the Letter of Permission issued for Starting of the above course shall stand cancelled which shall result in forfeiture of right of the college/institution to admit the students in the above course.

The college authorities shall take up the matter for recognition of the qualification under section 11(2) of the IMC Act at the time of first batch admitted against the course appears for final year examination.
