The interview cards were dispatched to the eligible and shortlisted candidates as mentioned in the list. In case, they do not receive it for any reason and their name appears in the list called for counseling, they can attend with original certificates and fees as per the following instructions.

The merit list is drawn basing on the marks secured in Intermediate or equivalent examination in the subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology & English with less no. of attempts.

More number of candidates are called than the available seats. Hence, there is no guarantee that all the candidates called for will get admission.

The candidates are informed to appear before the selection committee on the date specified below:

The BC, SC, ST candidates called on merit for open category seats on day 1 (14.07.2017) are also eligible to attend for category seats on day 2 (15.07.2017) for change of specialty.

The candidates have to attend in person with the following **certificates in original** for admission into B.Sc(N)/BPT/B.Sc Paramedical/DRT Courses.

1. Online application abstract.
2. SSC marks certificate
3. Intermediate marks certificate.
4. Transfer certificate
5. Study certificate form Class VI to Intermediate.
6. Recently obtained permanent caste in case of SC/ST/ BC categories for claiming reservation and scholarship from Govt.
7. Residence certificate (those who studied in an unrecognized institution or studied outside A.P / Telangana but resided within the state) Proforma is available in the institute's Website.



8. **Fees:** If selected, the tuition & other fees has to be paid by way of D.D. as per the details mentioned in the prospectus (B.Sc (N) /BPT-Rs.30,500/-, B.Sc Paramedical – Rs. 21,250/-, DRT-15,600/- failing which the selection stands cancelled.
9. Caste verification: The District welfare authorities (SC/BC welfare officers) will assess caste and category of the candidate and certify their eligibility for admission
10. **Fees reimbursement:** fees reimbursement facility is extended to the eligible SC/ST candidates subject to verification of certificates by the welfare authorities to the limit, prescribed by the Govt. The balance tuition fee shall be paid for claiming admission. The eligible SC/ST and other candidates shall bring their family income certificate, ration card & Aadhar Card for assessment.
11. **Special category:** In addition to the above, the candidates called under special category have to bring the original certificates as proof of claim.
 - i. **NCC:** Original NCC Certificate
 - ii. **CAP:** The original CAP Certificate from Zilla Sainik Welfare office, Discharge summary, ID proof, etc.

The children of Ex-servicemen (retired category)

- a) Original discharge certificate of her parent.
- b) Original Identity Card of her parent issued by Zilla Sainik Welfare Officer concerned district.
- c) Original Pension book of her parent if pensioner.
- d) Residential Certificates of the parent of the candidate issued by Tahsildar.
- e) Certificates of Gallantry Award, Gazette Notification, copies of part-II order and relevant documents if claims under Priority-I, Priority-II and Priority-III.
- f) Children of Armed Force Personnel Certificate issued by Zilla Sainik Welfare Officer.

The children of serving soldiers

- a) Original Identity Card of her parent issued by competent authority.
 - b) Original pay book / pay slips of her parent.
 - c) Residential certificate of the parent of the candidates issued by Tahsildar.
 - d) Certificate of Gallantry Award Gazette Notification, copies of Part-II orders and other relevant documents if claims under priority-II and priority-III.
 - e) Children of Armed forces personnel certificate issued by Commanding Officer. Failing which to produce the above documents in original his/her application under children of Armed Force Personnel (CAP) category will not be considered for admission into respective courses.
- iii. **PH:** The original Physically Handicapped certificate. Further, the medical Board of the University will assess the disability, whose decision is final.
 - iv. **TTD/SVIMS:** TTD/SVIMS category service certificate as per Annexure-IV of the Prospectus, Employee shall attend the counseling with original ID card.
12. Not attending to the counseling or failure to bring and deposit the required certificates and fee shall render the candidate forfeiting his/her right for admission and the next candidate in the order of merit will be preferred.
 13. The candidate has to attend in person for counseling. No proxy/representative is permitted under any circumstances.
 14. The candidates are instructed to comply with all the instructions stipulated in the prospectus prior to and after admission.
 15. The seat matrix is displayed in the website separately for B.Sc (N), BPT, B.Sc Paramedical courses.
 16. The un-reserved seats are filled first followed by S.V University region seats.

17. The second & subsequent counseling schedule will be notified in the website. No individual communication will be sent. The candidates have to visit the website and attend for the counseling along with their certificates and fees.
18. Ragging is strictly prohibited. If any incident of ragging comes to the notice of the authorities, necessary action will be taken as per the institute/ Govt. norms. "**Online undertaking affidavit**" duly completed, signed by the student and parent shall be submitted on the date of joining in the O/o the Principal of the college concerned. - i. If your name is not found in the list, you need not to appear for the counseling on the dates mentioned above.
- ii. **The attendance will be taken from 8.30 a.m to 10:00 a.m only.** The candidates who attend the counseling beyond 10:00 a.m will not be permitted to attend the counseling.
- iii. The selected candidates have to deposit all the original certificates on the day of counseling and they will be returned only at the time of leaving the institution. Hence, they are **advised to keep sufficient no. of Xerox copies of certificates** with them for future use.
- iv. There is no guarantee that all the candidates called for counseling will get the admission. All the seats will be filled up based on merit following the rules of reservation in vogue.
- v. The decision of the selection committee in allotting the seats shall be final and binding.
- vi. The candidate who fails to attend the counseling on the said date will forfeit the right for admission.
