Alleviating human suffering has been part of dedicated services of Tirumala Tirupati Devasthanams to mankind. To provide the most advanced medical services to the needy, the TTD has launched a monument, a blessing from the lord by opening Sri Venkateswara Institute of Medical Sciences, an AIMS (New Delhi) – like institute at Tirupati.

SVIMS was conceived in 1986 on the lines of AIMS, New Delhi and foundation stone was laid on 18.4.1986 by Late Sri. N.T. Rama Rao, the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Andhra Pradesh in the world

famous pilgrim town of Tirupati. It was established with a view to provide Super Specialty facilities at nominal cost to the poor.

SVIMS Hospital started functioning from 26.2.1993. The institute was upgraded in 1995 to the level of university by an act of AP State Legislature, within a short time of its establishment.

The healing touch of SVIMS has covered most of Andhra Pradesh and neighbouring states. The major objectives of SVIMS include service, training and education in advanced medical sciences and technology. Latest technology in diagnostics and total computer automation of patient care has been implemented in this institution. The computer centre is equipped with high speed internet access.



The new central library started functioning from February 2017. The students and faculty are allowed to access high quality medical journals and literature.

Apart from Health care the institute offers several academic programmes in Modern Medicine, Physiotherapy, nursing basic medical sciences, biotechnology, bioinformatics and other Allied Health Sciences. SVIMS is one among the few institutes in the

country running 10 super speciality and

10 Broad Specialty courses starting from the academic year 2003-04 onwards with the permission of Medical Council of India.

SVIMS-Sri Padmavathi Medical College for Women in its seventh year of functioning with intake of 150 students for every year is one of the premier institutions in Andhra Pradesh with good teaching faculty, infrastructure, latest equipments and imparting well organized and advanced teaching and training to the students. The



college building was formally inaugurated by the then Hon'ble Chief Minister of Andhra Pradesh on 16-12-2016. The present students' strength is 800 with an intake of 175 students from the academic year of 2019-20 onwards, due to hike of 25 seats as to implement of EWS category reservations. For the fresh MBBS batch for the Academic Year 2021-22, the admission process was already commenced.

The recognition of MBBS course of SVIMS-Sri Padmavathi Medical College for Women for award of MBBS degree (150 students) granted by SVIMS University on or after January, 2019 was approved by the Board of Governors in Supersession of Medical Council of India u/s 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956 vide Endst.No.MCI-34(41)(R-6)/2018-Med./187199, dated 13-03-2019.

The newly constructed Sri Padmavathi Medical College hospital with 650 bed strength was inaugurated by the Hon'ble President of India, Sri Ram Nath Kovind on 01-10-2017. The then Hon'ble Chief Minister of Government of Andhra Pradesh Sri Nara Chandrababu Naidu and the then Hon'ble Governor of Government of Andhra Pradesh and Telangana, Sri E.S.L. Narasimhan also attended the inaugural function



The OP & IP services in the specialties of General Medicine, General Surgery, Obstetrics & Gynaecology, Paediatrics, Ophthalmology,

E.N.T, Dermatology, Dental Surgery, TB & Chest and Psychiatry are presently being run in the new hospital building developed by APMSIDC with an estimated cost of Rs.98.86 crores.

The MBBS girl's hostel was inaugurated by Hon'ble Vice-President of Government of India, Sri M. Venkaiah Naidu on 07-08-2017. The hostel for MBBS women students 144 rooms (72 rooms single occupancy and 72 rooms triple occupancy) and supporting facilities. The hostel building was constructed with an amount of 16.4 crores and the 2nd block MBBS hostel construction work is in progress.

The faculty are actively involved in research activities0 with the financial assistance of national and international agencies.

Cfar Building: The Centre for Advanced Research building

#### **Objective of the Institute:**

To create a centre of excellence for providing medical care, educational and research facilities of a higher order in the field of medical sciences in the existing super specialties and such other super specialties as may develop in future, including continuing medical education and hospital administration.

### PARADOX

**Paradox:** A statement or proposition which, despite sound (or apparently sound) reasoning from acceptable premises, leads to a conclusion that seems logically unacceptable or self-contradictory (1) and it appears unless and until we don't know the depth in it.

## THERE IS NO WORD CALLED PARADOX IF WE FIGURE OUT THE MISSING DETAILS IN IT.

#### **Types of Paradoxes:**

- 1. Subjective paradox
- 2. Objective paradox

**Subjective paradox:** Formed due to misinterpretation or misplacement of important details regarding the situation

**Objective paradox:** Formed Due to perpetual motion, which is impossible to create in a four-dimensional world. It's just an illusion created by an artwork.

There are no objective paradoxes existing in a real-world

So now, only subjective paradoxes are present.

#### Why subjective paradoxes will occur?

Subjective Paradox will occur when we wrongly interpret the situation or we miss any important details, these subjective paradoxes will occur.

#### Famous paradox

- 1. Ship of Theseus paradox
- 2. Paradox of court
- 3. Omnipotent paradox
- 4. Bootstrap paradox
- 5. Grandfather paradox
- 1. Ship of Theseus paradox: Suppose Assume, A ship of Theseus is made up of ten parts, If you replace one by one and completely replace all the ten parts, with all the replaced ten parts, we can make a ship, right! So the question is which is the original ship of Theseus? Replacement ship or replaced ship? (2)

**Solution:** when the question is about identity, like who are you? You have to answer or show your structure abilities or impacts or thoughts or achievements or work done with respect to its space-time. So the answer should be Structural and functional abilities with respect to the sailing time of each part So by applying this principle After replacing the 10th part both the ships are homologous to each other, but none of the ships would match the identity of the ship of Theseus at any given point of time. Because of the difference in the sail-time of each individual part.

In simpler words, If the Structure and function of A+B+C+D+E+F+G+H+I+J and the SAIL TIME of A+B+C+D+E+F+G+H+I+J Parts are equal until, just before the replacement of a first part, and thus the original identity for the ship of Theseus, after replacement of all TEN parts, the two ships are structurally similar, but both of them missed their identity with the original ship of Theseus. Because of the difference in their sail-time of each individual part. (3)

2. Paradox of Court: Assume there are 2 persons A and B, A is the advocate, B is the Trainee After successful completion of the course by a trainee, he has to pay the amount after winning the first case, as a fee for his training, this is the bond between them, but unfortunately trainee won't take up any cases, after some time, the advocate sued a case on the trainee, regarding his fee amount If Trainee won the case, He has to pay the amount, because of the bond between them If Trainee loses the case, Again he has to pay based on the court orders. (4)

#### How do you solve this case?

**Solution:** So I appoint one of my friends as my advocate, As matters of freedom, It's purely my wish, whether to take up any case or not, so now the case was dismissed, and I won't pay any amount to the even after winning the case Because I won the case as a respondent, not as an advocate. Because my friend was my advocate, and I am the respondent.

The important detail missed in this paradox was, at the time of the agreement, the trainee has to ask, to mention the side of winning too, like winning as a lawyer or as a respondent/petitioner.

**3. Omnipotent paradox:** Can an omnipotent being create a stone so heavy, that they can't lift it? (5)

**SOLUTION:** The paradox arises, because of failing to mention the level of omnipotence

According to holy books, God will be formless, omnipotent, and omnipresence, but the point of negligence is WHERE? That is, Where God will be as formless, omnipotent, and omnipresence? AT WHAT LEVEL?

**Answer:** Definitely God is formless omnipotent and omnipresence, BUT ONLY ABOVE THE LEVEL OF UNIVERSE and these kinds of things or events such as stone, lifting force, gravity, plane, acceleration, buoyancy forces these all are confined to at the level of the universe, so we can't compare the items between two irrelevant things. So If God comes to the level of the universe, definitely they'll lose their omnipotence and omnipresence. And they must have to follow the path of nature set by them.

EX: 1+1=2, based on NEWTON's The PRINCIPIA MATHEMATICA or SUN RISES IN THE EAST BASED ON THE OBSERVATION FROM EARTH, these all are universal facts, that means these statements will become truth, in this universe only, even god also can't change it. If the observer was present above the level of the universe, or in another universe definitely these facts also MAY change.

4. **Bootstrap paradox:** A Theoretical proposition in which, by means of either retro causality or time travel, a sequence of events is among the causes of another event, which is in turn among the causes of the first-mentioned event. Such causally looped events then exist in space-time, but their origin cannot be determined. (6)

**Solution:** origin can't be determined due to neglecting the impacts of one space-time on another space-time.

created due to travel

If you consider the level of impacts of two spacetimes one on each other, you will determine the real source, with respect to time.

In 2020 covaxin was discovered, which means up to 2019 there is no covid vaccine, and no coronavirus, if i knew the formulae for the covid 19 vaccine, and went back to 2019, i'll become the source for the covid 19 virus and its vaccine, because of impact of my space-time shows impact on covid virus as well as on bharath biotech.

**Solution:** here the point of negligence is the impact of one space-time on another space-time.

**Grand father's paradox:** the grandfather paradox is a paradox of time travel in which inconsistencies emerge through changing the past. The name comes from the paradox's description: a person travels to the past and kills their own grandfather before the conception of their father or mother, which prevents the time traveller's existence? (7)

Solution: this paradox arises due to the negligence of bootstrap paradox and interaction



When grand-son space-time interacts with his grand-father in this situation, there are multiple possibilities

- 1. If both are alive, there will be separation of their space-times, and grand father constitutes to his present spacetime.
- 2. If grandson is only alive, grandfather will be born to him, via his father (in a reverse direction) and constitutes to his present space-time
- 3. If grandfather is only alive, again it continues to present spacetime
- 4. If both are dead, there will be interaction of their space-time with other events in this universe, or with other universe which constitutes the same cycle again and again.
- Shape of space time: based on this observation, the shape of space time may be presented as 8. But a small portion in it will appear as a linear or circular There is no word called paradox, unless and until we know the depth in it
