All the eligible Graduates who have applied for receiving Degree in person are requested to attend the Convocation function as per the schedule. Further, all the awardees are hereby informed, that as per the UGC guidelines, to follow the dress code as detailed below;

- 1) <u>To assemble at the venue two hours before the scheduled time (i.e.,1.00 p.m)</u> with prescribed dress code (as mentioned above) and college ID card.
- 2) Before entering the Auditorium they are advised to collect respective student stole, admission pass and convocation booklet at the specified place near the auditorium on payment of Rs.200/- (non refundable). The student can retain the stole and no need to return it to the University. The student has to compulsorily bring the exact denomination for Rs.200/-.
