

**Editorial:****The Journal of Clinical and Scientific Research: the march forward!**

The Journal of Clinical and Scientific Research (JCSR), a peer-reviewed, quarterly, free full-text, print and online indexed journal that charges no submission fees, processing fees or publication fees was born in the year 2012 on the occasion of the Sri Venkateswara Institute of Medical Sciences (SVIMS) celebrating its 19th Anniversary. The journal has attracted more than 80 submissions per year from across the country and abroad in its first four years of existence. Every year, in an attempt to encourage authors who publish manuscripts in the journal, the JCSR has been awarding the “Best Paper Award” in the “Original Article” and “Case Report” categories. From 2014, the JCSR has provided Digital Object Identifier (DOI) numbers, the unique identification of the article and Quick Response Code (QRC) guiding to online access of the articles.

This peer-reviewed journal promotes electronic submission and this along with presence of free-full text online will be a boon to young researchers who wish to publish their research work. Also, no fees are charged for submission, processing and publication by the journal. Thus, JCSR encourages vibrant young faculty researchers and postgraduates to submit their work for publication in the journal. So far, 20 issues have been published without any missing issues and every issue on time. The journal gets distributed to all the Medical colleges, Medical institutions, Medical Universities, R&D institutions in the country.

The journal is already indexed in Index Copernicus, Academic Index, Open J-gate, Directory of Open Access Journals (DOAJ), Journal Seek, Indian Science Abstracts, Geneva Foundation for Medical Education and Research, New Jour, Academic Journals Database, Research Bible and Directory of Research Journals Indexing (DRJI), several of which are listed by the Medical Council of India (MCI) as necessary requirements for recognizing a publication by medical college faculty. Further the JCSR uses “iThenticate”® for plagiarism prevention services. JCSR as calculated by Scientific Journal Impact Factor (2012) was 3.432; Index Copernicus Value (2015) was 68.5. The process of getting cited in Indmed, Pubmed and Embase is being pursued.
