He gave a history of snake bite about 5 years back for which he was admitted and treated with dialysis, from which he had recovered completely. There were no history of paraesthesia, cold or heat intolerance, wash basin attacks, difficulty to walk in dark surroundings and narrow paths. He gave history of reduced appetite from the past 6 months and difficulty to swallow solid foods.
