The major objective of SVIMS includes service, training and education in advanced medical sciences and technology. Latest technology in diagnostic wing and total computer automation of patient care has been implemented in this institution for the first time in our Country.

Physiotherapy College is a recognized college in Andhra Pradesh by the Director of Medical Education, Government of Andhra Pradesh, Indian Association of Physiotherapy (IAP) and it is recognized as a one of the best college in India. Aims of the conference:

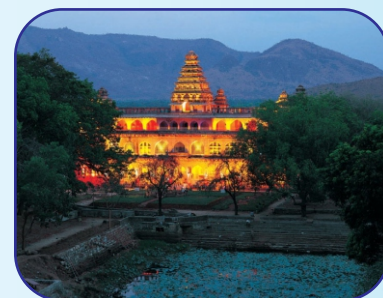
“Movement towards progress”
